Burton Football Club Player Rules

1. **Player Membership to the club will be made annually by enrolment in accordance with the applicants own wishes with the approval of a parent or Guardian**
2. **An Enrolment fee of £10.00 (to be determined by the committee annually) will be required with the completed application. First time applications require a copy of a birth certificate. The enrolment fee covers league and cup entries, affiliation fees, insurance requirements and may include a contribution towards club funds. NO PLAYER SHALL PLAY IN AN OFFICIAL MATCH UNLESS ENROLLED AS A MEMBER AND REGISTERED WITH THE APPROPRIATE LEAGUE.**
3. **Subscription charges will be necessary to cover weekly expenses and should be paid weekly on a training day or periodically as required by the general committee as voted on at the AGM. The subscription rate will be reviewed and set at the discretion of the club committee.**
4. **Training will be arranged at the discretion of the team management in preparation for and during the league, cup competitions and tournaments.**
5. **Team selection will be made by the team manager on training days for subsequent matches or tournaments. Players not attending training will not be considered for team selection unless prior notice of availability and fitness is given and the management consider the reason for absence from training is reasonable. (In such cases team selection will be at the management's discretion)**
6. **Matches will normally be played on Sunday afternoons for 11-16 and Sunday mornings for Mini Soccer. However, match days and times may vary.**
7. **All major expenses will be met from club funds. However, players may be required to attend fund raising events and competitions.**
8. **Players must provide their own BOOTS and SHIN GUARDS for training and matches. (wearing of shin guards is compulsory and the responsibility of the player.**
9. **The club will not be responsible for injuries to players or personal property.**
10. **Players will be required to register with the Football Association of who's league their team has entered. This will be valid for this particular season only. Once registered, with the exception of schools teams, players cannot register or play with another team without an official transfer.**
11. **The football association may request proof of a player's age and identity and may summon a parent or guardian to a disciplinary hearing if a player is suspected of breaking Football Association rules.**
12. **Payment for any fines incurred by a player through their own fault may be requested of the player or the player's parent or guardian. (such a request would only be made by agreement of the committee having considered the circumstances of the incident which resulted in a fine being awarded)**
13. **I also will abide by the Burton Youth Football Club code of conduct.**
14. **Burton Youth Football Club subscribes to the FA code of conduct and respect campaign. Parents, coaches and playing members have read the requirements of this code of conduct and by signing agree to the code of conduct terms and goals.**
15. **You subscribe to the Burton youth photography policy as published on the club website and reviewed from time to time. If you would like to opt out a form will be provided for you by the child welfare officer**
16. **Any and all policies and rules of the club are published on the club website as are events and other information. Policies are changed and voted on from time to time by the general committee. By enrolling to Burton youth Football club you agree to these rules.**
